Phase 1 of our build is complete. Below you can see the size of our well-resourced classrooms—we have more than 90m² of workspace! The children are currently working at extra large single seat-er desks, and the space gives us peace of mind in Covid times. All classes open on to a private garden and benches under the shady trees. The children love these quiet spaces to relax and play during breaktime or just to sit and read a book. Our gardens are landscaped and we are loving the feeling of calmness the beautiful grass and abundance of trees bring to the learning space.



The picture above shows the children in their smart uniforms. It's great quality and locally manufactured. We love that it is hybrid uniform so it's used for everyday class, physical education and for playing sport. It is made of quite hi-tech material which means it's cool in the summer, but offers some warmth on colder days. Changing in and out of uniforms really wastes valuable learning time, and the size of the lost property pile is also greatly reduced!
