# Year 1&2

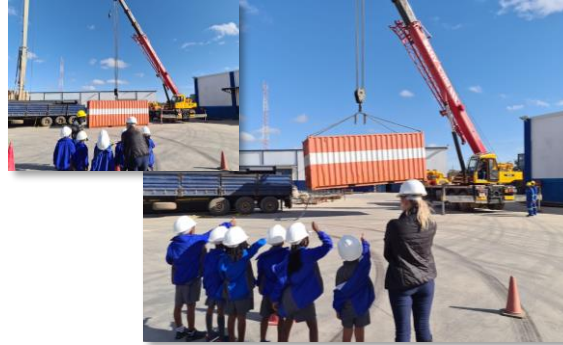
In Year 1 and 2 we were learning about what it means to be a good person and a great friend. We put our thoughts on paper. Are you a good friend?

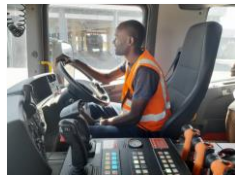




# KKIA Fire Department

# Sport

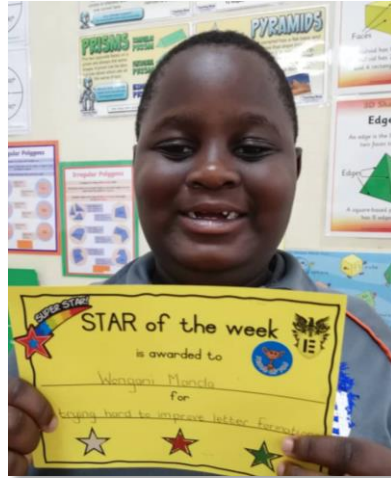
