Early Years



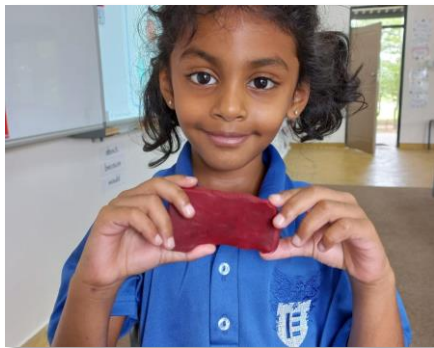

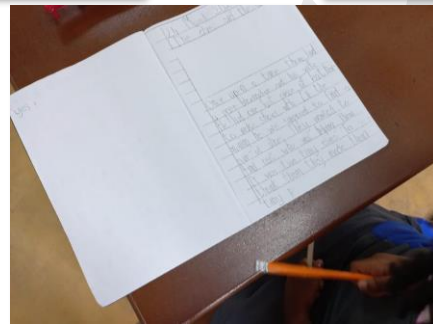

Year 1&2



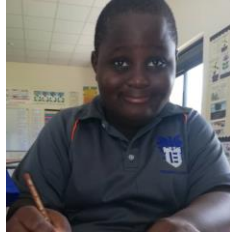
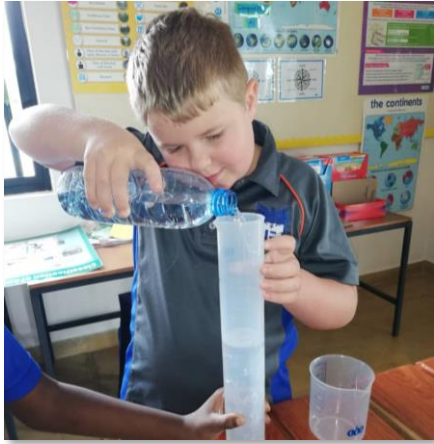
This week we learned about the names of 2D and 3D shapes and we spent some time creating our own shapes from play dough to understand the concept of faces and vertices better.
